

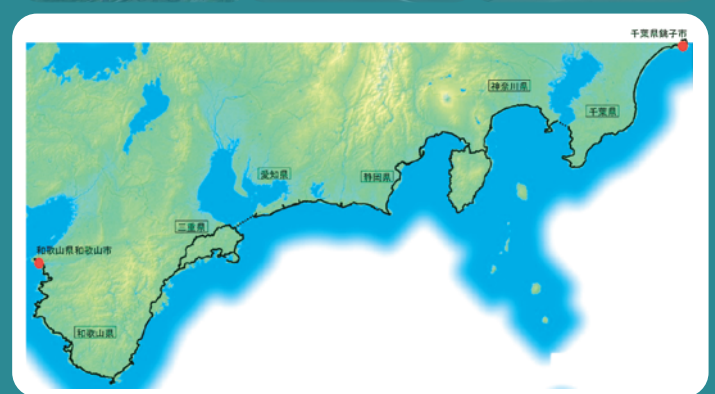


Pacific Cycling Road Cycling Map

Rules for Bicycles

- In general, bicycles are to ride on the road.
 - * Bicycles follow the same rules as cars
 - * Always ride on the left side of the road.
 - * When traveling on sidewalks, give pedestrians priority and travel on the road side of the route.
 - * When bicycles can normally use sidewalks
 - When there are signs indicating that bicycles may use the sidewalk
 - When the rider is under 13, 70 or older, or has a physical disability
 - When traffic conditions require riding on the sidewalk for safety
 - * Tandem bikes cannot use sidewalks.
- Obey traffic signals and always come to a complete stop at stop signs.
- Riding while using a cellphone, headphones with high volume or an umbrella is prohibited.
- Riding under the influence of alcohol and riding double (riding beyond capacity limit) are strictly forbidden.
- Do not ride side-by-side. Always ride single-file.
- Turn on lights at night and in tunnels.
- Get a bicycle damage liability insurance plan.

[Wear a cycling helmet!]

Many people dying in cycling accidents suffer serious injury to their heads. Prepare for accidents by wearing a helmet that will protect your head while riding.

✓ Safety Checklist

Regularly check the following.

- ☐ Brake adjustment
- ☐ Chain oil/air pressure
- ☐ Remaining light battery (front and back)

[Tire Condition]

- ☐ Cracks in the tread?
- ☐ Can you see the cloth/thread?
- ☐ Hole worn in the tread?
- ☐ Object stuck in the tire?
- ☐ Tire noise while riding?
- ☐ Recently inspected? (Recommended at least once a year)

If there is any problem, visit a bicycle shop for adjustment or repair. And be sure to get a checkup at a bicycle shop before a special event or long ride.

* Check brakes again before descending!

* There are many tunnels. Attach lights to both front and back!

[Beware of Thieves]

Nothing ruins your ride like a stolen bicycle. Don't let your bicycle be taken from a rack. If you can't see it, be sure it is locked!

3 Road markings and information signs

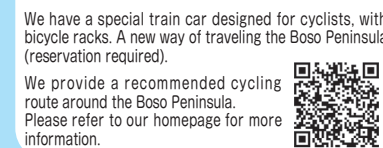


- The JR railway and some other public transport companies allow bicycles inside passenger carriages if they are folding bicycles, or if they are disassembled and inside a carry bag. Please inquire about the policy of each transport company.
- Bicycles with protruding or unfolded parts may not be allowed.
- Bicycles may be excluded during periods when transport is crowded.
- Please take care not to disturb others when disassembling and assembling your bicycle before and after your ride.

We have a special train car designed for cyclists, with bicycle racks. A new way of traveling the Boso Peninsula (reservation required).

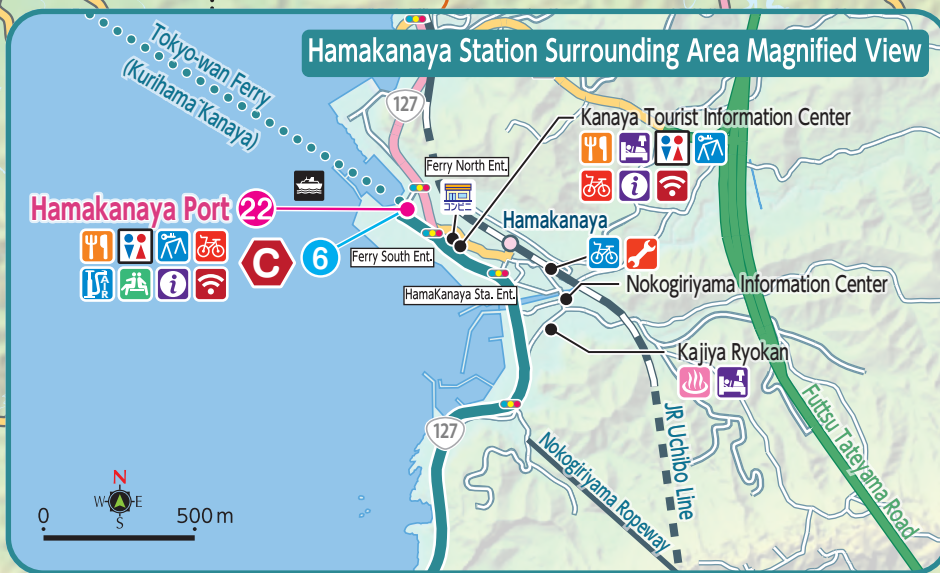

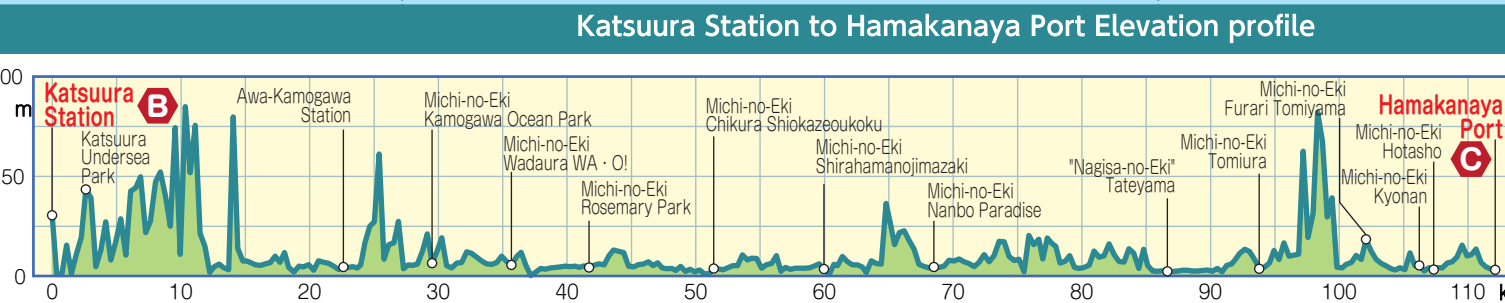
